- **May 12, 2006** – 2006 Student Technology Leadership Conference showcased CILC program via Internet2
- **May 16, 2006** – KY Community & Technical College System New Horizons Conference showcased CILC program via Internet2
- **May 18, 2006** - 1st KY participation in Megaconference Jr. by Frankfort Independent Schools, the first school district with Internet2 access

- **March 1, 2007** - University of Louisville and the University of Southern Queensland's "Southern Skies" as Internet2 showcase at KentuckyConnect's 2007 Tech Day
- **March 8, 2007** – Kentucky Teaching & Learning Conference showcased the use of Internet2 applications from Frankfort Independent and Scott County schools and "Southern Skies"
- **March 14 - May 18, 2007** - Frankfort Independent Schools participated in MAGPI's "One Book, One Philadelphia" – The Memoir Project in which the entire 11th graders learned to write memoirs as required by the Kentucky curriculum standards
