1. KEN Update – Ann Riggs

The KEN launch meeting took place June 19. The Executive Committee has approved the establishment of the IT Coordination Committee and the go-ahead with organizing work groups and proceeding towards implementation. We will be posted on the progress. The KEN pilot sites and their timelines will be determined by the Committee. I2 events will be the showcase for these pilot sites.

2. Internet2 Day – Mike Clark

We have commitment from Louis Fox, I2 K20 liaison, to be on site and Ann Doyle, I2 liaison for arts & humanities, to be remote for Sept. 22, Friday. The Applications Work Group discussed the programming in depth during a f2f meeting prior to this meeting.

The discussions were on the following:

- 2.1. Multiple sites for distributed and interactive speakers and sessions on each site;
- 2.2. Technical issues need to be brought to the I2 Technical Group for determining what is possible and what is not;
- 2.3. Target audience - Those who are not aware of I2 applications in the K20 community;
- 2.4. Live applications to show what's possible, not talking heads; use "Raising Mary" scenario to illustrate the applications;
- 2.5. Showcase UK and UofL I2 users and have them speak about their use and play mentor roles to other faculty if possible;
- 2.6. Cost and budget – Who to pay? Grants to be announced for use of I2 applications;
- 2.7. Theme – Show and tell
- 2.8. Faculty follow-ups in each campus
- 2.9. Grand finale of an orchestral piece performed by New World Symphony, UK, Fayette county Public School, EKU...

The Applications Work Group will work on the programming further.

3. I2 Web Site – Miko Pattie

The site is up; meeting minutes and events are up. We need to help build this site for our teachers, faculty, librarians, parents, administrators, media, etc. as the central site for communication. Everyone's help is needed to make it effective.

4. I2 Assessment Project – Tad Pedigo

Tad and Tim Smith are pursuing grant opportunities to build an assessment model for I2 applications. They have touched base with Blackboard and US Dept. of Education. NSF will be considered. (Gates Foundation to be followed!)
